




Vote Results:

Discuss at home:

- Whether you know of anyone who has chosen to donate their organs and why.
- What you think your decision might be once you are over 18.
- Which other approaches could work well in encouraging more people to donate.

Student research points:

- Find out more about how the system has been working in Wales since 2015.
- Explore where else in the world similar systems exist and when they began.
- Investigate one of the early examples of organ transplant and how this has evolved since.
